### **Superpower:**

### **Who you Know:**

**Credenza:** Your ex-girlfriend, now, who probably doesn’t want to talk to you. And you don’t want to talk to her so much as yell at her. She has the ability to talk to furniture, for whatever that power’s worth. Better than some people here, though.

**Copycat** is the newest member of the superhero team, and he’s stealing your girl. You should figure out how to undermine him whenever you can. So far he hasn’t ever actually been around when trouble has happened: is he some sort of coward?

### **One Note Characterization:**

**Sees the Worst in Everything.** Like a cynic or a picky eater, you refuse to enjoy anything, and constantly whine and complain. This is most obvious regarding Credenza, Copycat and Cell Phone Guy, but it applies to everything else, too. If you’re not doing something else, find something to complain about.
