
## The Test Run

The project has struggled with constant delays, budgetary concerns and technical malfunctions. The initial test run of the **Kerensky Translocation Array** didn't happen until three days ago, long after this project demonstration had been scheduled. The test had some problems of its own, though it appeared to be successful. The data from the test run is very odd, though.
