When Prophecy Fails

Take turns drawing the instruction cards and reading them out loud.



We are all believers of a fringe religious movement, centered around a prophetic figure.



Our prophet has foretold that the world is going to end on this very night.



They have gathered us, and only us, together to meet the apocalypse.



When the time comes, we will be saved even as the Earth is destroyed.



They have chosen us because they know that we truly believe their prophecies.



Let's choose an image of the prophet to decide what they look like.

(If you don't have any images handy, try searching stock photos online for "psychics".)



When the instruction cards are finished, we will continue with the question cards.



Everyone will take turns drawing questions and answering them.



Other players can ask question, suggest details, or find ways to relate characters together.



The person who reads and answers the question card always has the last word, though.



Let's place the X card in the center of the table, where it is visible and accessible to all of us.





If some question or answer would interfere with your enjoyment of the game, just touch the X card or say "I'm going to X card that"



When you use the X card on something, that content is removed from the game, and we invent something new to replace it.



When a question card is removed from play, the player who was supposed to answer it can draw a new card and answer that instead.



You can use the X card on your own card, or on another player's.



You can also pass a card that you were supposed to answer to another player, because it would be more interesting as a question for their character.



You can pass or X-card a card that was passed to you.



When a card says "someone here" or "who here", it refers to another player's character.



Setting aside the *Prophecy Fails* card, let's take the question cards and shuffle them now.



We play until someone draws the *Prophecy Fails* card.



We play until someone draws the *Prophecy Fails* card. Each player will answer that card in turn.



Insert the Prophecy Fails card into deck, near the middle for a shorter game or toward the bottom for a longer one.



We are now ready to play. We can take a short break, if anyone wants.

Whoever wants to go first can draw the first question card.



What profession did you leave in order to follow the prophet?



Why did you feel empty or alone in the world before finding the group?



How did you first come into contact with the prophet?



Why are you given so much authority in the group, despite being a relative newcomer?



Why are some others in the circle jealous of your relationship with the prophet?



Why are you given no respect or authority in the group?

Who here do you love most, other than the prophet? Why do you keep this love a secret?

What were your unfulfilled hopes and dreams in life, before joining the prophet's circle?



Who here is your family, by blood or by choice?



Why do you feel excluded or marginalized by mainstream society?



What emotional need did you have unfulfilled before joining the circle? How has this group help fill the void you felt?



What family member did you cut out of your life because they doubted the word of the prophet?



What have you done to disappoint the prophet?



What beliefs does the group borrow from more mainstream or familiar religions?



What beliefs from mainstream, familiar religions does the group reject?



What otherworldly forces aid or guide the cult?



What otherworldly forces seek to harm or destroy the cult?



What form will the cataclysm take? How will the believers be saved from the cataclysm?



What belief of the group would outsiders think is bizarre or strange?



How does the prophet receive their messages?



What other fringe group were you part of previously?

What previous prediction has the prophet given you that has proven true?



Besides prophecy, what other miraculous ability does the prophet claim to possess (but never demonstrates)?

What moral code or belief has the prophet given you to guide your decisions in life?



Which of the prophet's teachings lights a fire in your heart? Why?

The prophet gave a secret teaching to you and you alone, once. What was it and why did it disappoint you?



How have you prepared yourself for the oncoming apocalypse?



How have you suffered because of your beliefs in the prophet's teachings?



How have you tried to spread the word of the prophet? What has been the result of your proselytizing?



How have you changed your daily life in preparation of the cataclysm?



What command were you given by a higher power through the prophet? Why did you fail to follow it?



What command were you given by a higher power through the prophet? What sacrifice did you make to follow it?

The prophet chose you to perform a task that anyone could do, but only allows you to do so. What is it?

What harsh taboo or moral stricture must you all follow as part of the prophet's teachings?

How did you rearrange your life based on the belief that the world will end tonight?

What problems of your own creation will you have to deal with if the world doesn't end?



When did you know for certain that the prophets teachings were true? What convinced you?



What false stories have been spread about the prophet and the circle?

Why did you doubt the prophet when you first heard their message? What changed your mind?

As the date approaches, what has made you doubt the impending apocalypse?



Why did you also claim a prophetic ability? How did the prophet respond to this challenge of their authority?

What previous prediction has the prophet given you, that has yet to become true?



What prediction has the prophet given you, that can never become true?



What is your greatest regret in life?

What secret do you know about the prophet, that they keep hidden from the other members of the group?



What sacrifice did the prophet demand that you were most reluctant to follow?



What makes you doubt the prophet's teachings?



How has the prophet previously failed you?



What recent event has cast doubt on the oncoming apocalypse?



Who has already left the circle? What caused them to abandon the prophet's teachings?



What makes you hope that the predicted cataclysm never comes to pass?
